Terms and Conditions

Entries accepted 9am to 5pm on 2nd, 3rd and 4th August at Carnarvon Civic Centre. OPEN 6 pm Friday 11th August and every day until 6 pm Wednesday 23rd August, promoting the appreciation and sale of the art displayed.

Entries for all categories will close at **5pm Friday 4th**th **August**. No entries beyond this point. **Entry fees** are non-refundable. \$25 per art work in categories 1 to 7, up to five art works per artist. \$5 per student art work, in categories 8 and 9, and only one entry per student, which is not for sale.

Entrance Eligibility. Entrants must be over 18 years of age as at August 11th 2023, and must have left school to enter categories 1 to 7.

Art Sales. All art works, except those of students, must be for sale with the price quoted by the artist. A commission of 20% will be deducted before payments are made, within 60 days of August 23rd 2023, unless payment instructions are missing or incorrect. Artists will be notified of sales of their works at the end of the exhibition or on collection of art work.

Best Overall Art Work, selected from categories 1 to 7, will be the only art work which cannot be sold. This is an **acquisitive award**. The artist will receive **\$8,000** from the Shire of Carnarvon in exchange for the art work. If the quoted price of the art work falls above or below \$8,000, the art work will still be exchanged for \$8,000.

Cash prize for **Runner-up to Best Overall Art Work** is \$2,000. Cash prizes of \$800 will be awarded for best art work in each category 1 to 7. A cash prize of \$350 will be awarded to a senior student for best art work in category 8. A \$200 art supply voucher will be awarded to a primary school student for best work in category 9.

The Aboriginal Artist Award of \$1,200 is for the best art work submitted in categories 1 to 7 by an Aboriginal artist, offered by the Aboriginal Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, with \$450 for **runner-up**. This is not a category of its own. Australian Aboriginal artists are very welcome to enter.

Winners will be announced, and prizes awarded, on Opening Night, Friday 11th August 2023, except for **People's Choice**. Throughout the exhibition visitors will choose and vote for their favourite entry so that **People's Choice** prize, of \$600, can be awarded at the Closing Party on August 23rd, at 6 pm.

Non-compliance. Art works which do not comply in full with the terms and conditions and details in the correlating entry form **may be excluded**, which includes lack of appropriate hanging device. Art works must have been created since the last Gascoyne Arts Awards in Oct. 2021. Art works which have been created before Oct 2021, or are already sold, or are commissioned works not able to be sold, or have won prizes in other exhibitions, **will not be accepted**.

The Gascoyne Arts Society Inc. reserves the right not to exhibit art work if deemed unsuitable and the artist/s will be duly notified. PAGE 1 OF 3

Terms and Conditions of the Annual Gascoyne Arts Awards continued...

Art works can be in any medium, e.g., paint, pencil, pen and ink, charcoal, wood, metal, string ..., but must not exceed an area of three square metres, or a volume of three cubic metres. All art must be entered in one of the following categories:

1. Gascoyne Landscape — location must be noted on Part B of entry form.

2. Gascoyne Seascape — location must be noted on Part B of entry form.

3. Still Life — collection of inanimate objects.

4. Three Dimensional - 3D Art includes sculptures, carvings, weldings and other art forms which occupy physical space and can be perceived from all sides and angles.

5. Contemporary — also called modern or abstract art, but not three dimensional.

6. Human Form — includes life drawings, portraits, depictions/scenes of a person or people.

7. Black and White Photography of a construction (buildings, any man-made structure) or of humans and their pets — singular or plural.

8. Senior Student — any piece of art by a student aged 12 to 18 years.

9. Junior Student — any piece of art by a Primary School student.

Artists can submit up to five (5) individual art works, including diptychs or triptychs, except for students, who can only enter one art work each. Each work must be titled and parts A and B of the Entry Form completed and signed by the artist or his/her attorney.

All works must be suitably framed and/or stretched. All works must be fitted with appropriate hanging devices such as 'D' rings and wire.

Deliver art works complete with entry form and entry fee to the Carnarvon Civic Centre, 2nd, 3rd and 4th August between 9 am and 5 pm. Entries close 5 pm August 4th, 2023. You can send entry fees on line to GAS Inc. BSB 066509 acc 10202423, with the artist's name on entry form or forms as I.D.

The Gascoyne Arts Society Inc. reserves the right to reproduce entries for publicity, catalogue, future years marketing material and archival purposes in association with the award. No work will be removed or photographed by visitors to the gallery during the currency of the exhibition. The works will be curated with all care by the Gascoyne Arts Society Inc. during storage and for the duration of the exhibition. However, insurance for art works while in transit or whilst being stored and exhibited by Gascoyne Arts Society Inc. is the artist's responsibility.

Unsold art works must be collected by the artists from 10 am to 2 pm Thursday 24th and Friday 25th August and from 9 am to 12 midday on Saturday 26th August, from the Civic Centre, whereupon they will be given a receipt for their art work. Art works which are not collected will be stored at a fee of \$20 per day until collected. All Judges decisions will be final.
