Shire of Carnarvon Residential Fence Information & Checklist



Approval:

A building permit is required for fence construction due to Carnarvon's cyclonic rating.

Please note:

Development approval is required for a front fence that exceeds 1.2m in height or 0.75m in height where it is located within 1.5m of any driveway at the front boundary and should be obtained prior to submitting a building permit application.

Fees:

There is a minimum fee of \$171.65 payable upon submission of a building permit application, consisting of a \$110.00 application fee and a \$61.65 Building Services Levy. Additional fees are payable when the estimated value of the proposed building works exceeds \$20,000.

The Shire of Carnarvon requires that all fences are certified by a structural engineer. Current, signed original copy of the documentation to be submitted.
