By law all cats need to be Microchipped, sterilized and registered, it is also a good idea to have your cat vet checked. wormed, flea and tick checked and vaccinated. The local vet will help you.



Why Microchip?

It is a legal requirement to have your cat microchipped in Australia. This is so that if your pet gets lost it can be returned to you. If you move, go online and change your details to keep it current.

What is the registration cost?

Sterilized: Lifetime \$100 **3yrs** \$42.50 **1yr** \$20 Pension: 50% less of Sterilized or Unsterilized.

By following these simple steps, with a little training and a lot of cuddles, play and attention you and your new cat will enjoy a lifetime of companionship, love and joy.


