IMPORTANT PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMMENCING YOUR DIARY

The Dog Act states that a local authority may take action against a dog owner if at least 3 people from at least 2 different properties are affected by the dog's noise and are willing to declare that in writing (and in a Court of Petty Sessions if need be).

- 1. The top number in each box <u>represents the actual time of day</u> when the dog was barking ie. 30 = 2.30am or 45 = 3.45 etc.

 - (06) = the dog barked for 6 minutes commencing at 1.15am
 - (10) = the dog barked for 10 minutes commencing at 7.20am
- 3. The "X" mark in each box <u>represents the time when you are not at home.</u>
- 4. Do not write anything in the box during the times when the dog is not a problem and when you are home.
