





# INTERESTED IN NOMINATING AS A COUNCILLOR?

## STEP 3

#### CANDIDATE PROFILE

All candidate profiles must:

- Be in English;
- Have no more than 1,000 characters (including spaces);
- Not contain false, defamatory or misleading information;
- Fit on an A4 page;
- Include the candidate's full name and contact information; and
- A photograph, no larger than passport-sized and taken in the last six months (optional).

# STEP 4

#### A DEPOSIT OF \$100

A \$100 deposit to be made in either:

- Cash
- · Bank Deposit
- · Postal order

made out to the Local Government.

## STEP 1

## CONFIRM YOUR ELIGIBILITY TO NOMINATE FOR COUNCIL

- · Be 18 years of age or older;
- Be an Australian citizen or British subject prior to 26 January 1984;
- · Be an elector of the district;
- If a current council member, have a term that ends on election day, unless you are standing for mayor or president directly elected by the public; and
- Have completed the mandatory Local Government Candidate Induction.

# STEP 2

## COMPLETED NOMINATION FORM

 Fill out a nomination form and sign the declaration

#### Things to ensure -

 The name to be printed on the ballot paper for a local government election must be your surname and one or more of your given names (or an initial or commonly accepted variation)

### Things to note:

- All nomination applications must be signed by the candidate in front of a witness.
- The nomination application must be submitted to the Returning Officer during the nomination period.
- Allow sufficient time to finalise any required changes before the close of nominations.
