By-laws Relating to the Management, Use and Letting of the Waroona
Memorial Hall and Associated Buildings.

L.G. WR-7-17.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby records having resolved on the sixteenth day of September, 1976, to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following by-laws:—

1. Application for the hire of the Waroona Memorial Hall and other buildings under the control of the Council shall be made to the Council Office not less than 24 hours before the hour at which hiring is desired.

2. Hirings of the hall and buildings, including furniture and equipment, shall be at rates set out in the schedule "A" hereunder.
