

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1960-1974.
The Municipality of the City of Stirling.
By-laws Relating to Officers and Employees.

L.G. ST/7/20, V.2.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby records having resolved on the 21st day of January, 1975 to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following By-law:—

The By-laws of the City of Stirling published in the *Government Gazette* of the 12th May, 1971 are amended in the following manner:—

- (1) By-law 166 is amended by inserting after the "Town Clerk" the words "Deputy Town Clerk".
- (2) By-law 170 is amended by adding after the words "Town Clerk" the words "or Deputy Town Clerk".
- (3) By-law 174 is amended by deleting the words "Assistant Town Clerk" and inserting in their place the words "Deputy Town Clerk".
- (4) After By-law 181 the following new by-law is inserted:—

Management Executive.

181A. (1) The Management executive comprises the Town Clerk, the Deputy Town Clerk/Senior Administrator and the City Treasurer/Assistant Senior Administrator.

(2) The Town Clerk may and if directed by the Council shall delegate specific authority to a member or members of the Management Executive over another or other senior officers as defined by By-law 166 and require the Senior Officer to report direct to the member of the Management Executive so nominated by the Town Clerk notwithstanding that a by-law may require the Senior Officer to report to the Town Clerk.

Draft Model By-laws (Holiday Accommodation) No. 18, with the following alteration:—

After the words "municipality of" in the first definition of By-law 2 add the words "the Shire of Carnarvon."
