



CAMPING ADVICE

Thank you for visiting the Shire of Carnarvon and we hope that your stay is enjoyable. In order to make your stay as pleasant as possible you are reminded of a few basic rules that apply to camping in this Shire.

YOU CAN CAMP

In areas which are signed accordingly, such as roadside rest areas, caravan parks and designated National Parks.

See Main Roads rest areas roadside amenities such as toilets and dump points.



YOU CAN NOT CAMP

Within the Carnarvon or Coral Bay Townsites, at, in or on any car park, boat ramp, beach, sand dune, industrial area or roadside.

Do not rely on the absence of '**NO CAMPING**' signs as an indication that you are **FREE** to camp at a certain location.

If you are found to be camping in an area that is not approved for that activity:

- Your vehicle registration details will be recorded and entered into the Council's database.
- An infringement for illegal camping may then be issued.
